## FOR YOUR APPOINTMENT, PLEASE BRING WITH YOU:

1. Original proof of citizenship:

(original or certified copy of birth certificate, naturalization certificate).

2. Acceptable form of ID:

(driver's license, existing passport, military ID, or other current government ID).

- 3. Photocopy of the front and back of the citizenship documentation and form of ID.
- 4. Current passport photo:

(if you do not have one, the Library can provide one).

- 5. Payment for the application in the form of a check made out to the U.S. Department of State (\$130 for adult, \$100 for minors).
- 6. Payment for the processing fee in the form of a check or cash made out to the Cutchogue New Suffolk Free Library (\$35).
- 7. Payment for the photo in the form of check or cash made out to the Cutchogue New Suffolk Free Library (\$15). Not required to take photo at the Library.
