

Dear Seniors:


Graduation from high school marks a beginning. Always keep in mind that learning is a lifelong process even though phases of your formal education will soon be ending.






HARRISON JAY BACHRACH




DEBORAH L. BAILEY




RE ANNETTE BAUER


Billy has been a valuable asset to our basketball team. He enjoys winter sports, especially snow-mobiling. He is a hard worker, but always seems to enjoy what he does.

When he joined our class last year, Dave added greatly to the school band. He likes science class best and his hobbies include sailing and scuba diving. Dave plans to attend college after graduation.



Dan is shy with people he doesn't know well. He is interested in music, art work, and creative writing. Dan would like to become a physical therapist.




ILSA BOHN




JOSEPH BRUNO BOKINA
