Thoughts on Another Local College-Bound Scholarship CNSF Library Friends Meeting – March 28, 2023

Some numbers:

Any recent year - 3 NoFo HSchools with 200 graduating seniors - 175 college-bound

MHS -- Class of 2022 about 108 seniors/100 going on to college (89%)

Mattituck High School listed some 85 locally-sponsored scholarships presented at 2022 commencement Awards to 150 recipients – some multiple recipients but pretty widely dispersed More than \$100,000 in total

\$1200 average scholarship/each recipient \$600 – some multiple recipients (valedictorian/salutatorian)

Not likely to be that different at smaller Southold and Greenport high schools –

My hunch: This sort of funding too small to be a significant factor in college-going (yes or no) and college-selecting decision (which college?)

My larger hunch: North Fork college-going a random process where decisions are made with too little information to hand. Under-thought decision

Less research than buying nest car, truck, lawnmower...

Default decision -1. The closest, seemingly the cheapest, and least hassle/doubt over admission prospects

 \rightarrow More 1/3rd to SCCC;

More than half to a NY State public;

70% to "non-selective" or "less selective" colleges

Why the information deficit –and resultant outcomes? Demographic

Schools too small to devote serious guidance time to college-going – none with a full-time college counselor

Schools too small and out-of-the-way to attract the interest of college recruiters \rightarrow College Nights

Not much in the way of active college alumni associations out here

Other possible but unlikely and despairing explanations:

Schools not that good?

Students not that good?

Parents unsupportive of securing the best education for their children?

What to do?

- 1. Secure better data on NoFo college-going than presently provided the community
- 2.Encourage more collaborative/less siloed efforts in college-advising process (combined College Nights; recruitment visits by the three schools)

- 3. Make more information/sources of information available Make the 4 libraries a more contributing part of the process as source of information, host of events
- 4. Friends of CNSF Library create a fund to support CNSF Library effort to become so, taking a lead if need be
