We wish everyone the best of luck and happiness in his and her future!

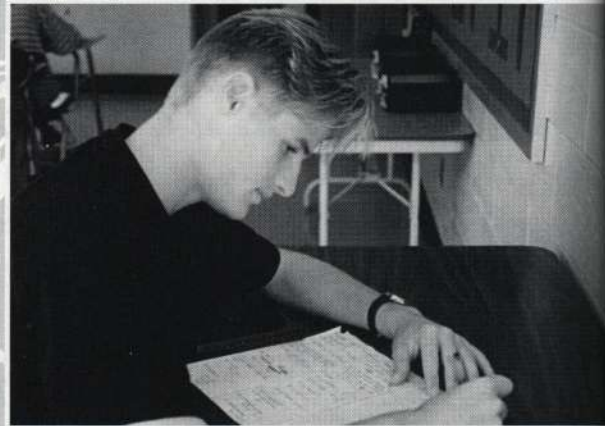
