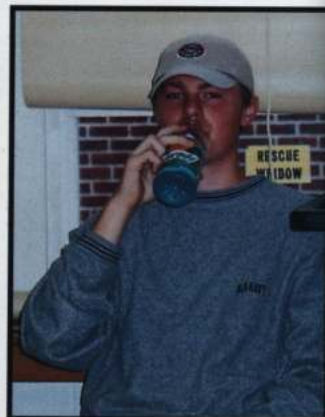

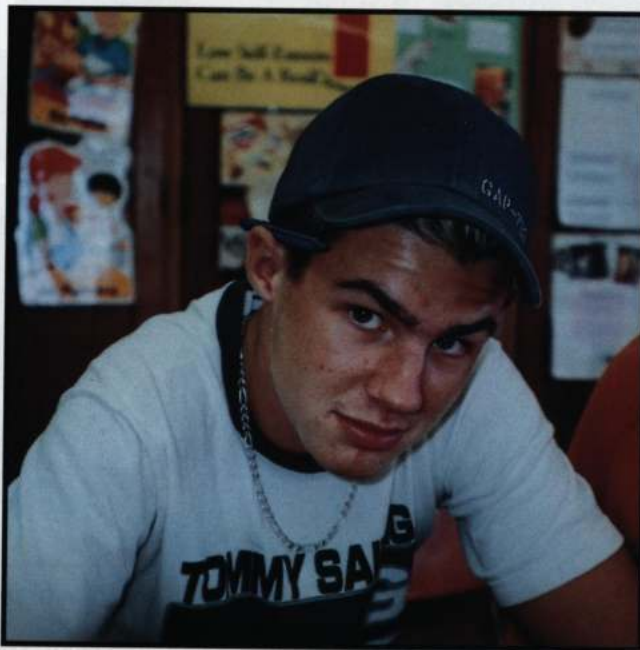


# Junior High at Mattituck
