WE ARE INCREDIBLE.

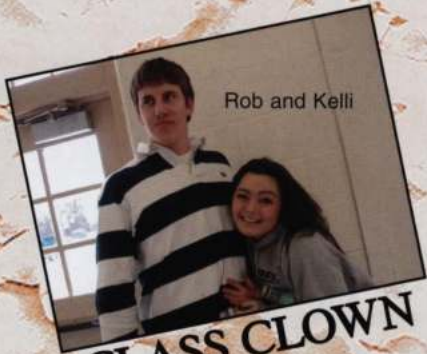

and live life everyday as if it were your last."

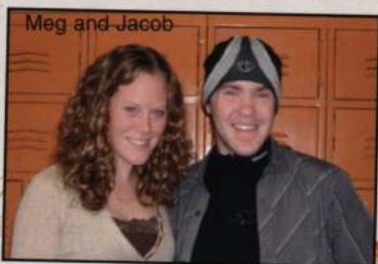
